Such participants shall be identified by the parties as participants in Royal Oak/Madison consortium adult education program. Royal Oak shall exclusively be responsible for the pupil accounting and reporting requirements necessary for Royal Oak to receive funding for such program under the School Aid Act enforced during the 2015-16 school year.
